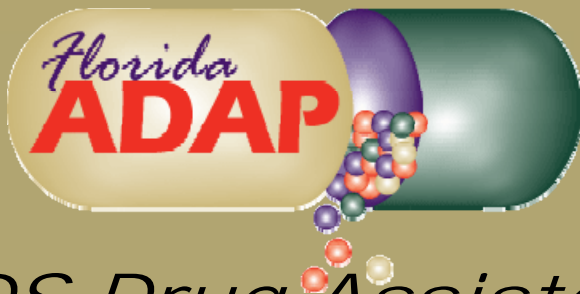

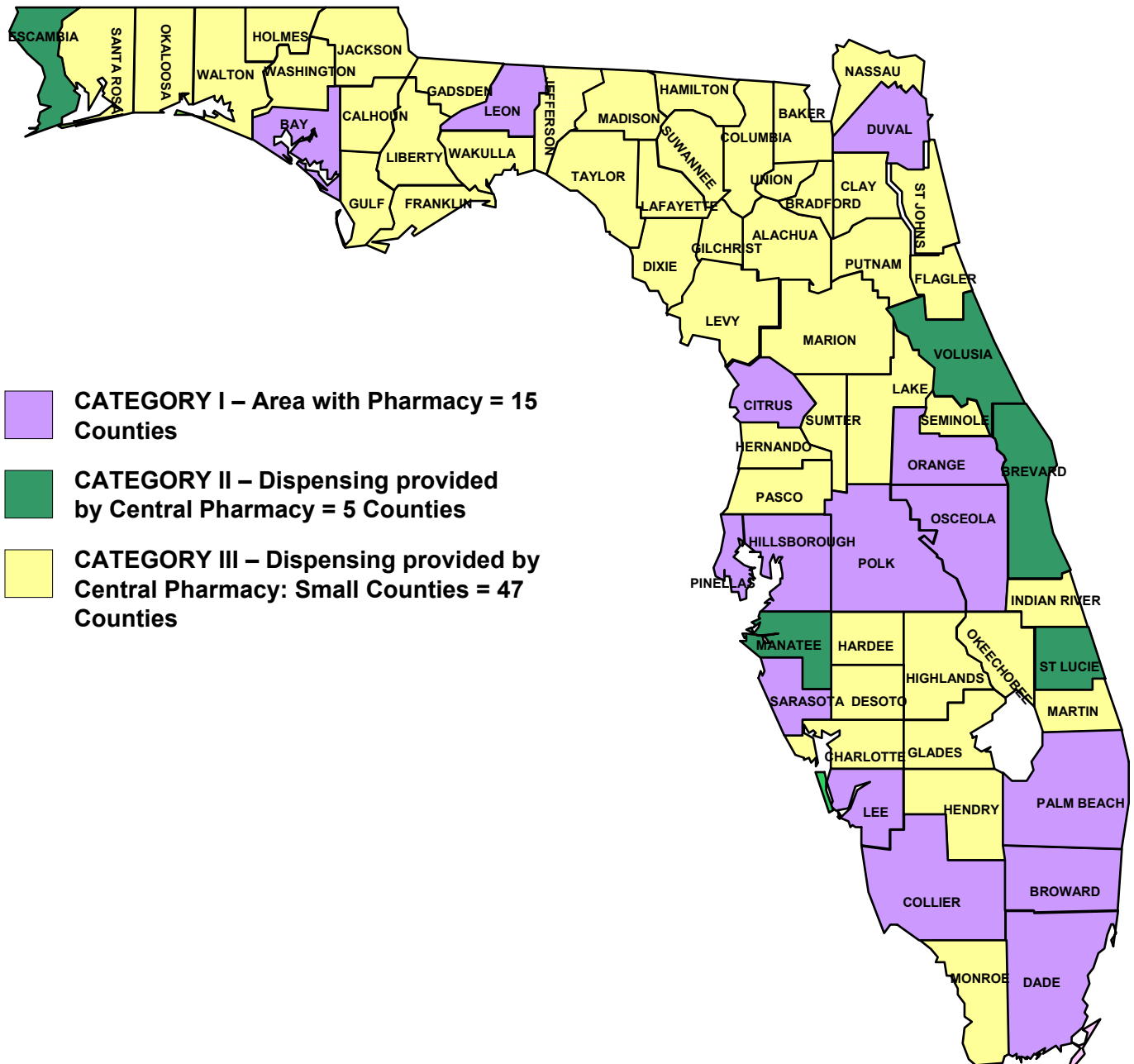

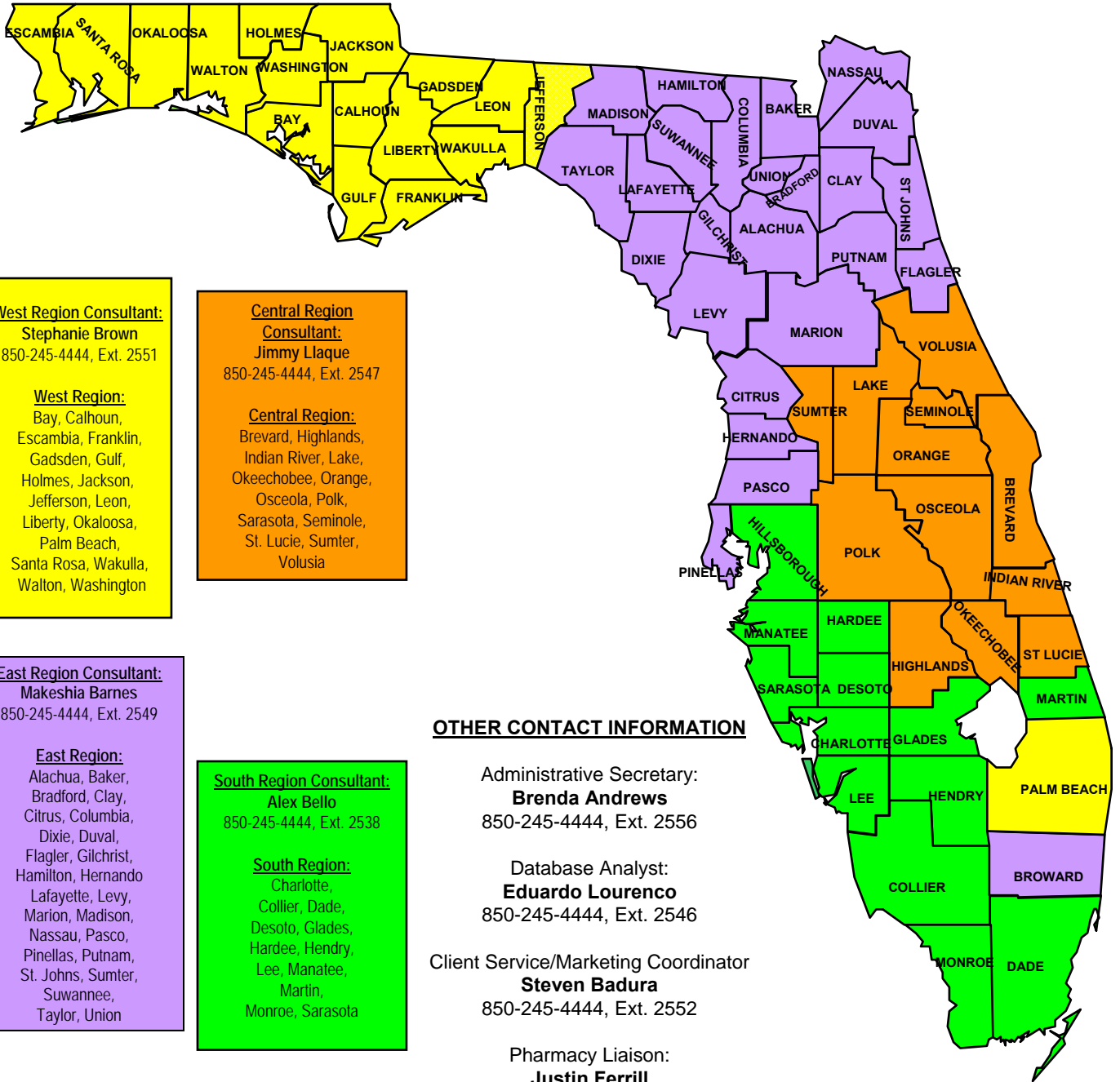

STATEWIDE PICK-UP PERCENTAGE

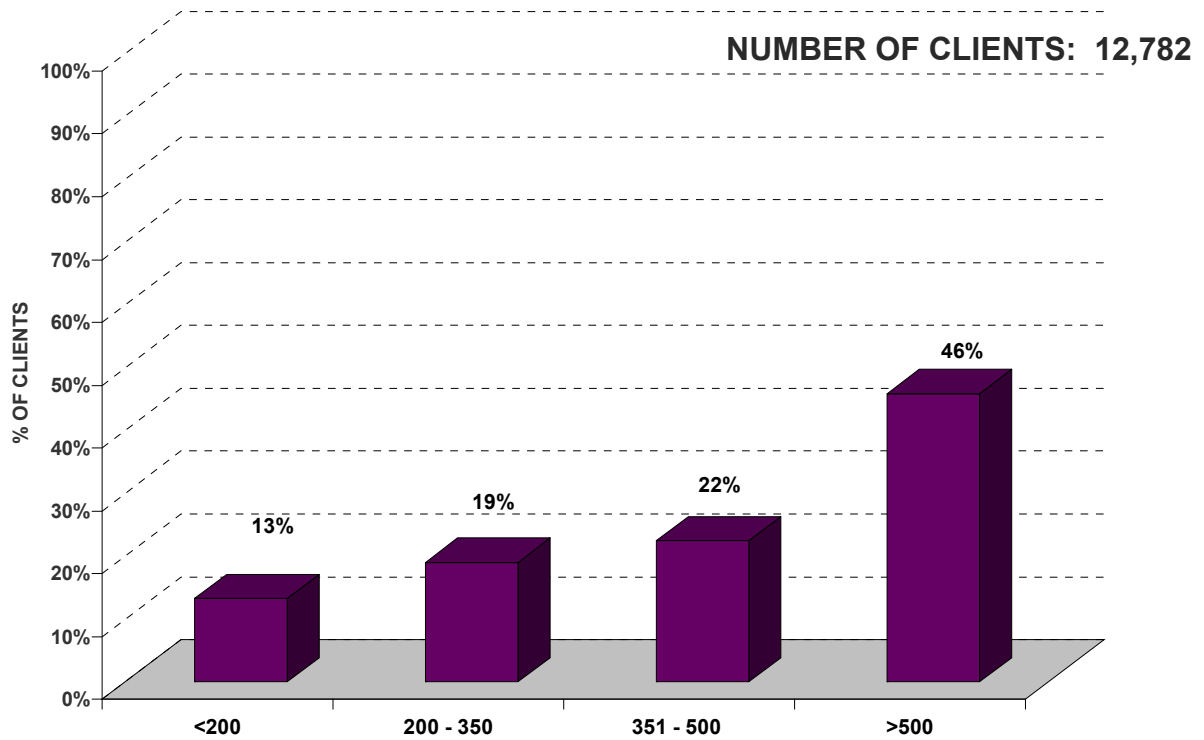

Statewide pick-up percentage is based on the total number of clients who picked-up at least once within the month.

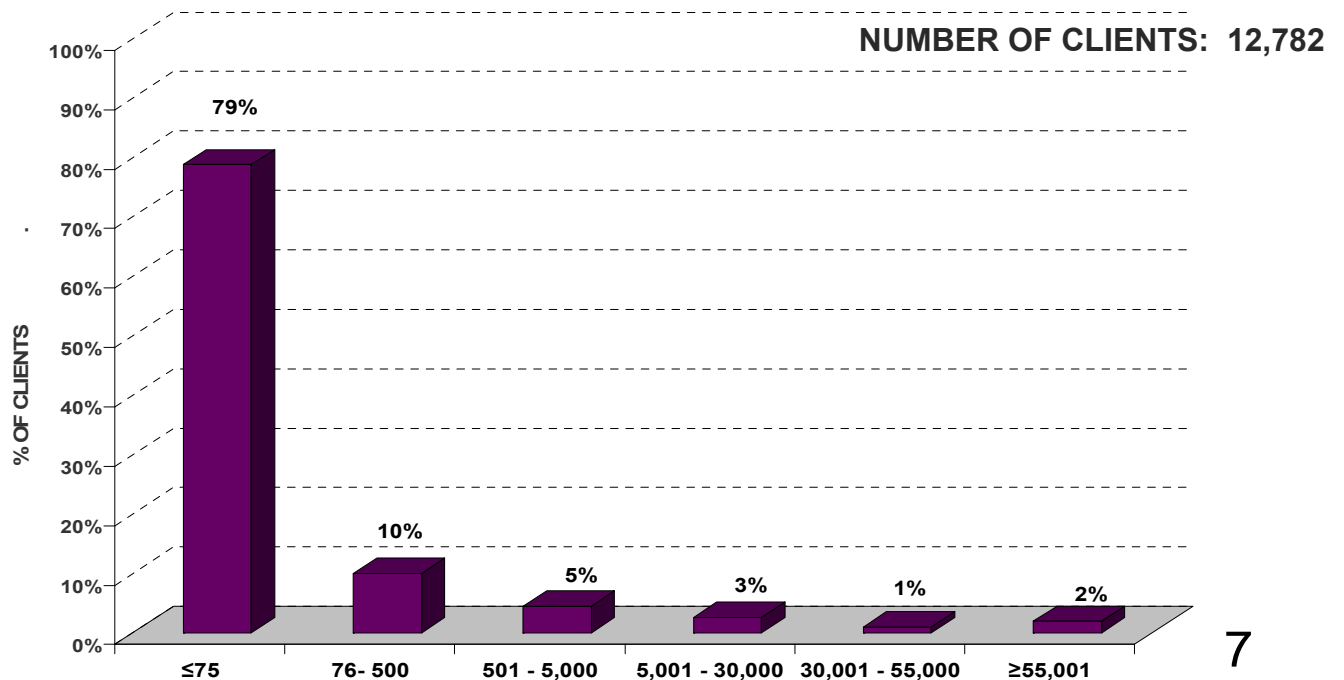
CLIENT CD4 COUNT

CLIENT VIRAL LOAD COUNT

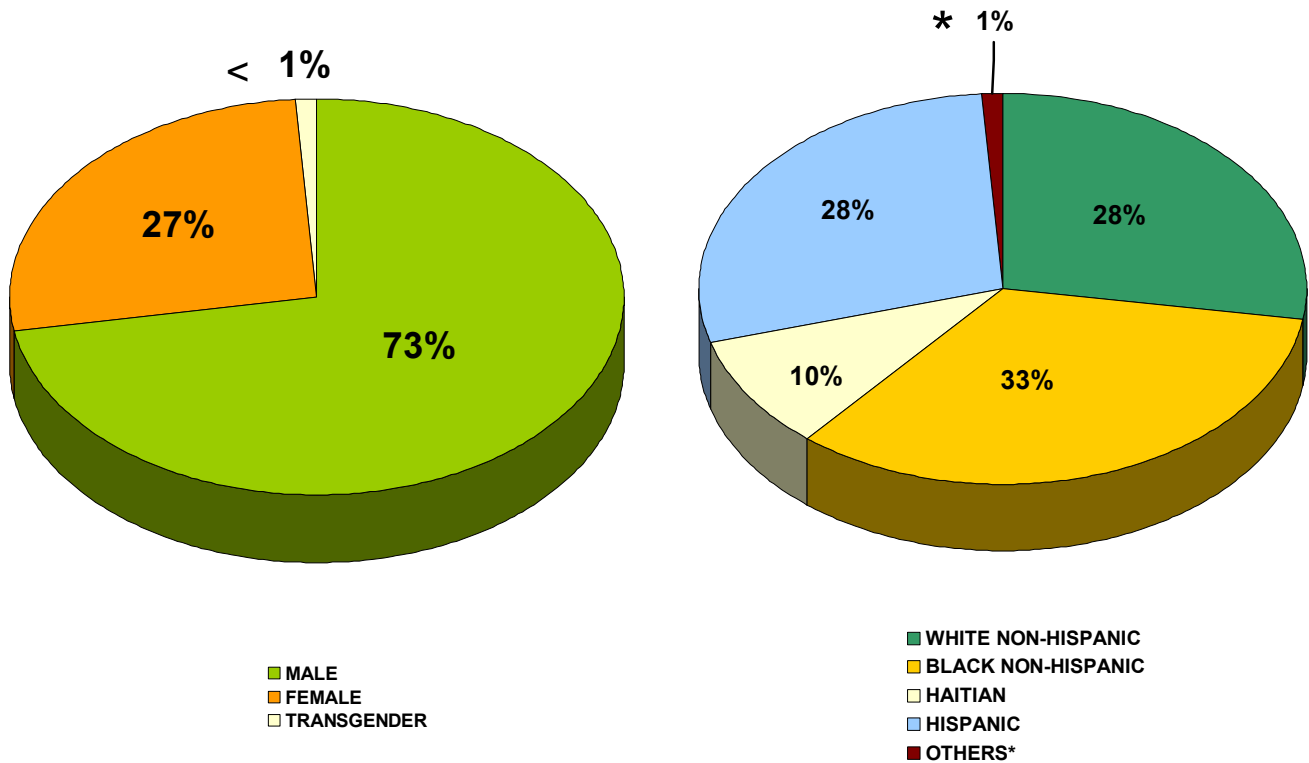

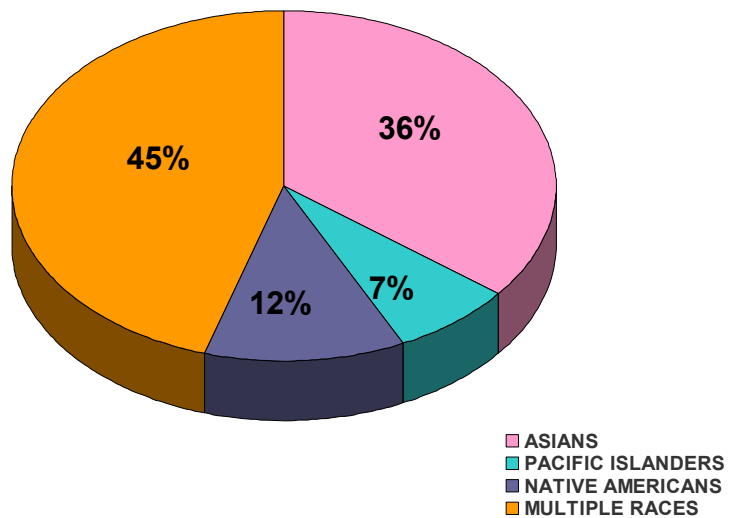

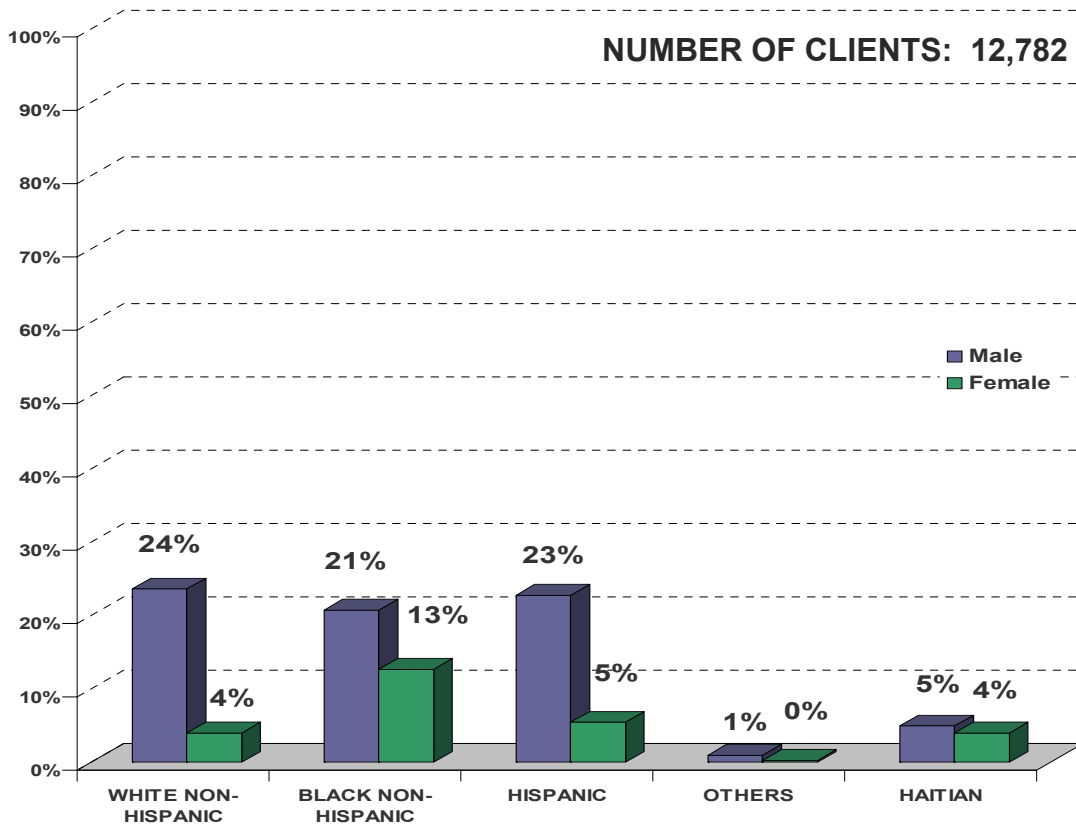


RACE/ETHNICITY OTHERS* (152 CLIENTS)

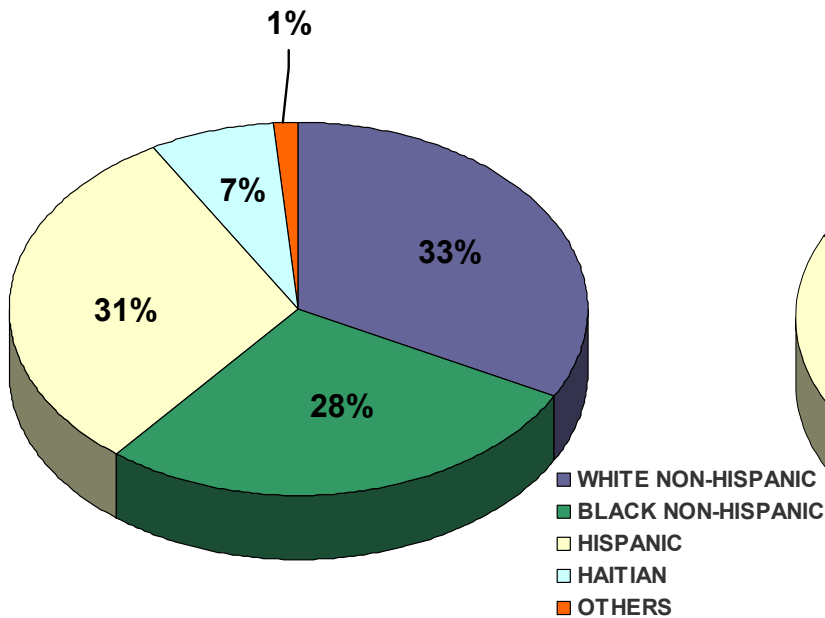


GENDER BY RACE/ETHNICITY

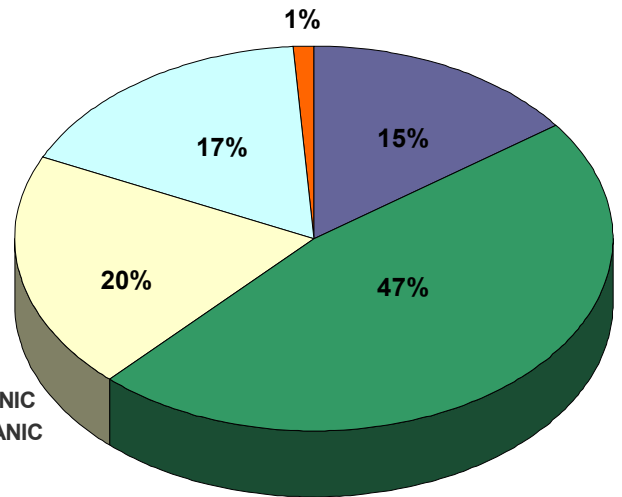

MALE (9,308 clients)



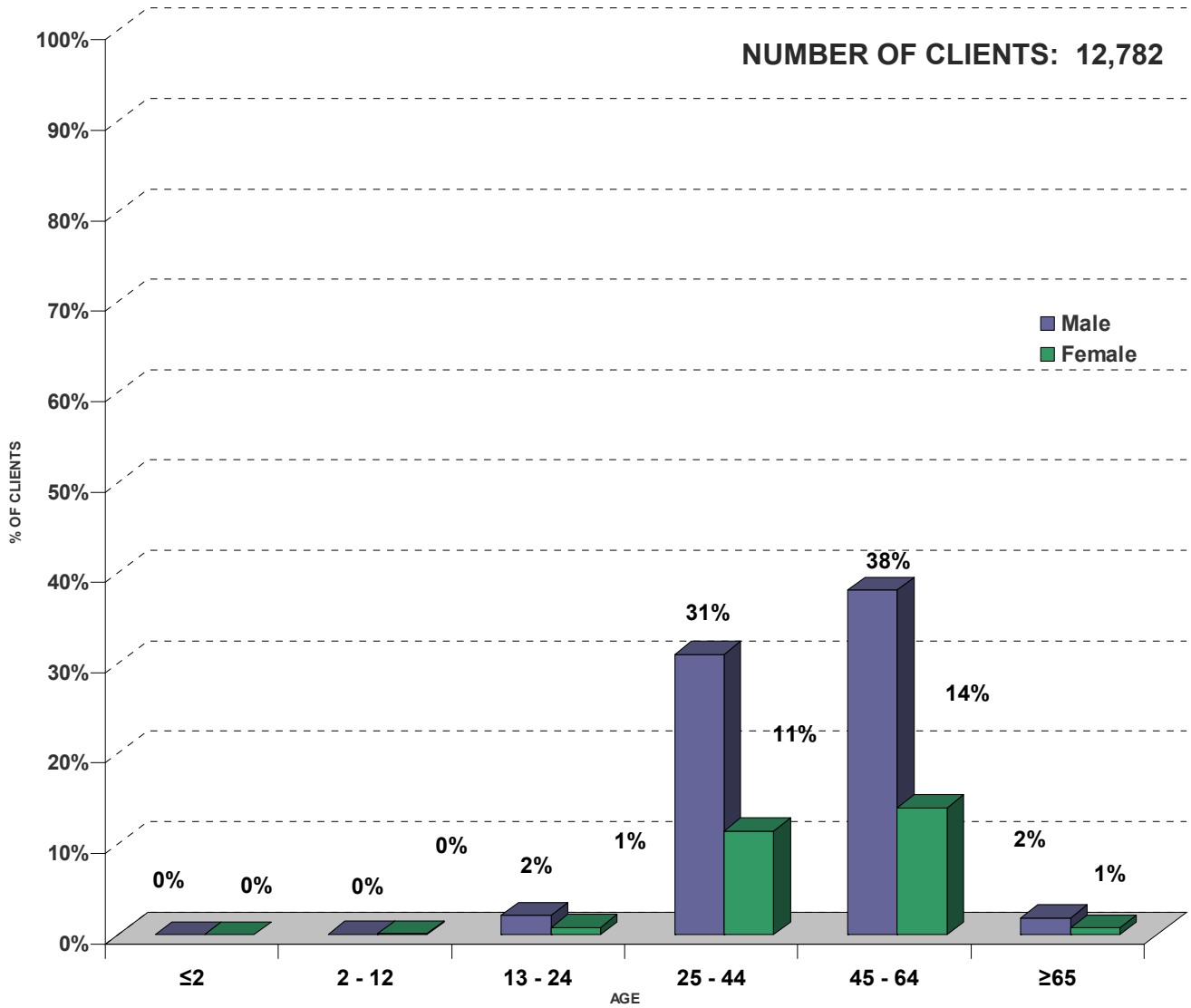
FEMALE (3,450 clients)

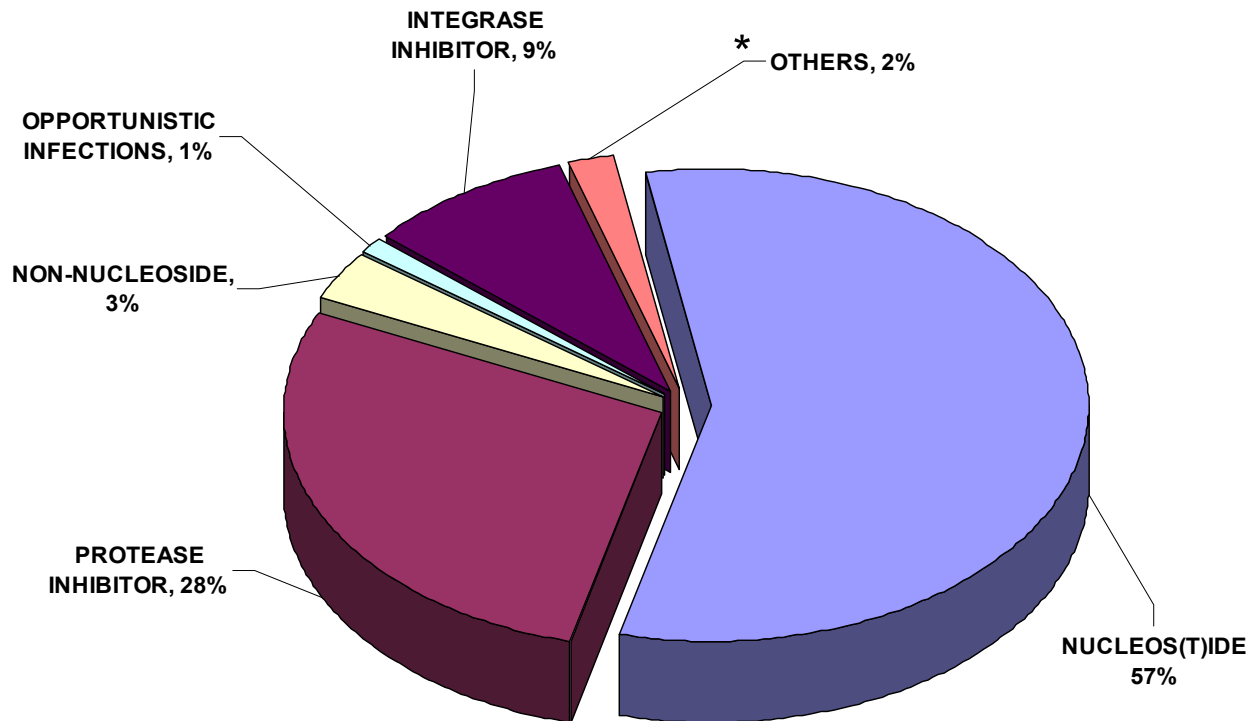

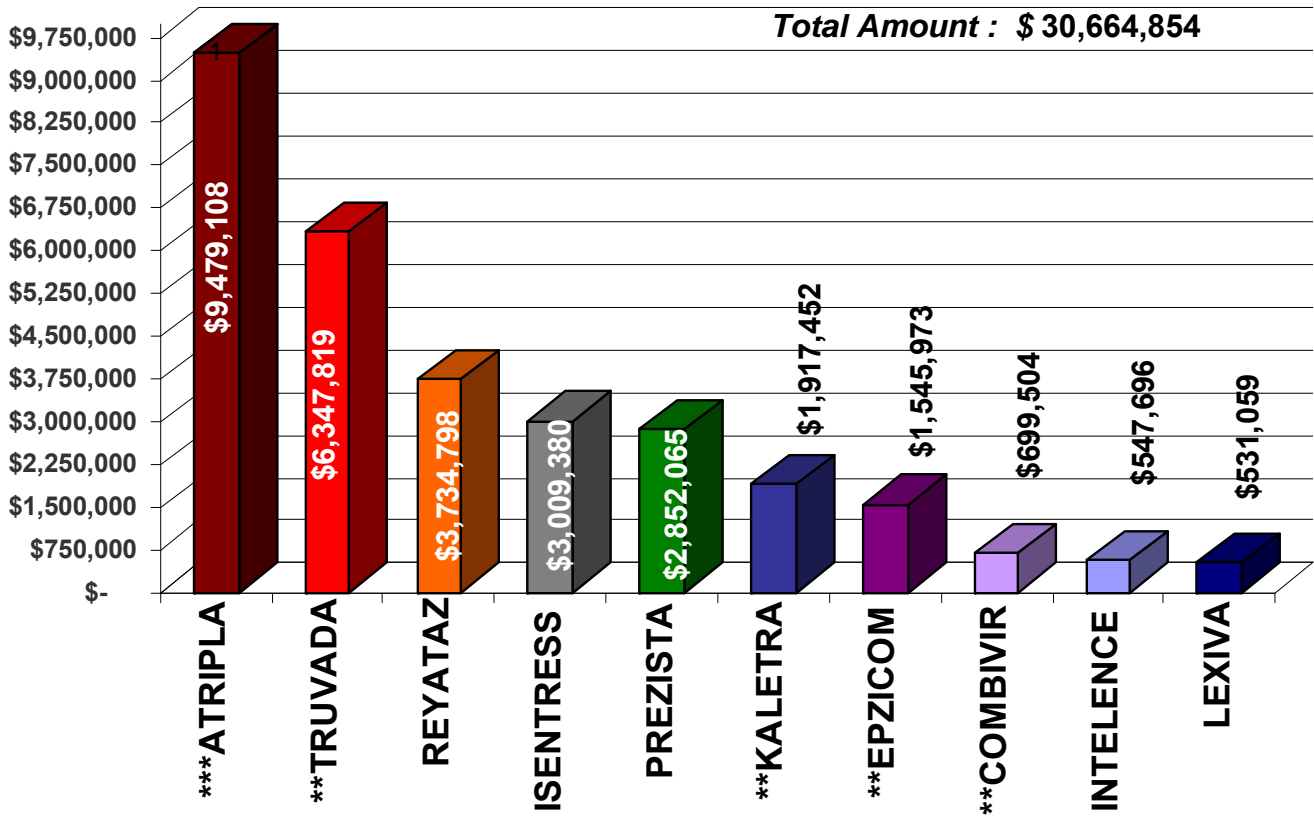
